## LCJE welcomes new members

In 1980, The Lausanne Committee for World Evangelism (LCWE) sponsored the Consultation on World Evangelisation (COWE) in Pattaya, Thailand. "Reaching Jews" was one of the 17 mini-consultation groups at that event. The enthusiasm of the leaders in the field of Jewish evangelism who attended to expand the network gave rise to the formation of a task force, now called the Lausanne Consultation on Jewish Evangelism (LCJE).

LCJE has met for international consultations every 3-4 years and more often on a regional basis. There are chapters in N. and S. America, Europe, Israel, South Africa, Australia, Japan.

A quarterly bulletin is published to keep its members abreast of what is happening in between consultations.

Membership is open to Jewish evangelism agencies, congregations engaged in Jewish evangelism, scholars and writers in the field, individual agency workers, and congregational leaders.

LCJE is a forward-looking organisation committed to see the next generation of Jewish evangelism leaders better trained and equipped and networked with others doing this vital work. If you want to be part of a creative, cutting edge and cooperative environment and
